About the Competition

The Bonnie Newhaven Competition is owned and run by the charity Newhaven Heritage Centre (NHC). The competition is a free to enter competition aimed at those who love Newhaven and its environs. The aim of the competition is to show off the original village and its new sibling, Western Harbour with high quality and beautiful photography.

Dates

Competition opens for entries on [Monday 21 May 2018](#).

All entries will be by uploading by email to photos@newhavenheritagecentre.org.uk. The entries will be posted onto Newhaven Heritage's Social Media sites at the first opportunity.

Shortlisting the entries will be influenced by the amount of likes received although the judges' decision will be final.

The deadline for the entries is midnight on [Sunday 19 August 2018](#).

High resolution files (4Mb or more) for the final judging must be submitted upon request by midnight, Friday 31 August 2018

Judging of the overall winner will be by public acclaim and will take place on Saturday 15 September 2018

Entry Conditions

The competition is open to both amateur and professional photographers

All entries must be taken within the environs of Newhaven village and Western Harbour within the period January 1st 2017 up to the date of entry.

Entries can only be submitted digitally.

Entrants are permitted to enter five images to the competition via the email address, photos@newhavenheritagecentre.org.uk.

Entries must be [landscape in format](#) with at least [1200 pixels on the longest length](#).

A high-resolution image with a minimum of 4Mb, and preferably [over 6Mb](#), will be requested for the entries that are shortlisted. The entry may be disqualified at the judges' discretion if not provided.

Images must not include watermarks, borders, or signatures.

Black and white images are eligible.

[The entrant must be the original artwork creator and solely hold the copyright.](#)

All images entered must not have been previously submitted to other competitions, or to an image library, or have been previously published.

It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that all necessary permissions are obtained from any person featured in a photograph.

Any submitted image must not be entered into any other competition after being entered into the Newhaven Heritage Bonnie Newhaven Photographic Competition until the results have been announced at the public judging on September 15, 2018.

Ethics

Digital adjustments that maintain the integrity of the image are allowed.

Accepted digital adjustments include dodging and burning, changes to tone and contrast and cropping, as well as High Dynamic Range imaging techniques and focus stacking.

Copyright and Usage

Entrants remain the copyright holder to any images submitted by themselves.

Commended and awarded entrants agree to grant Newhaven Heritage and its partners and sponsors a non-exclusive irrevocable licence to reproduce, enlarge, publish and exhibit for any purpose related to the competition in any medium, including print and digital.

This includes, but is not restricted to; exhibiting, competition calendar, competition book, for use in press and on websites.

The entrants agree to Newhaven Heritage free usage sublicensing of the shortlisted images for press articles or any other external communications related to the competition.

After the winners have been announced entries will be deleted, apart from those that have been shortlisted.

Newhaven Heritage will try to ensure the photographers will be credited on all media, but in the event of inadvertent omission of the credit, the photographer agrees that the Newhaven Heritage is not to be held liable.

The entrant is responsible for any claim made by a third party against the submission.
